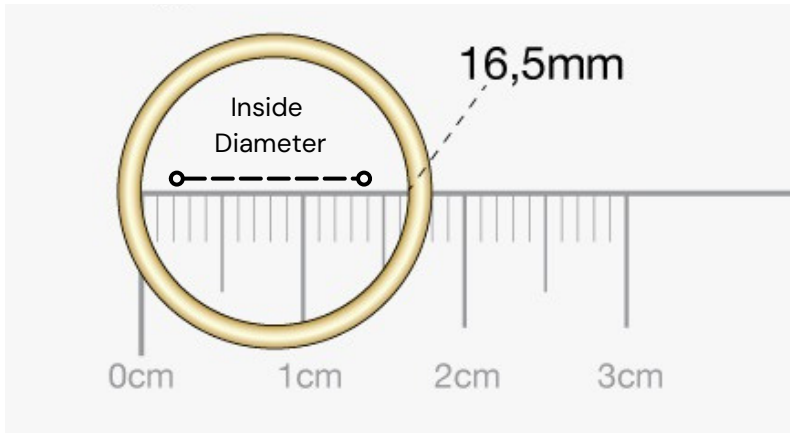

Before measuring your ring size, be sure this guide is printed in A4 Letter size & scaled to 100%

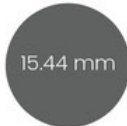


Option 1: Measure by Matching Your Ring to find your ring size, use an existing ring that fits you well. Match the inside of that ring with one of the circles below. When your ring has been placed on the right size, you should see only the grey circle- with no coloured space-inside your ring. if your ideal fit falls between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size..



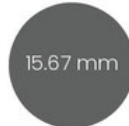

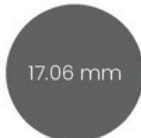

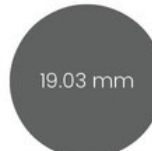

After you cut out the ruler, carefully cut the line to create a slit. Wrap the ruler around your finger at the base and pull the tapered end through the slit. To make sure the ring will fit comfortably, we suggest also measuring your knuckle We recommend selecting a size that goes on and off your finger easily.

Sizing availability is specific to each product, though some larger rings can be sized down. Ring size may also vary slightly depending on style of the ring.
